It also aims to teach students high academic reading skills, such as analyzing and understanding different types of texts with different topics, understanding the main idea of the text by estimating inter-phrases and finding semantic clues.

Planned Learning Activities and Teaching Methods	: The course is designed with a topic-based, multi-strand syllabus which includes comprehensive work on understanding and analyzing academic reading texts. The course continues throughout the whole academic year and evaluated on the basis of components specified in the performance evaluation section.
